

Glossary of Campaign Terms

Unenrolled/Independent - a voter is not affiliated with a political party

Constituency - Group of people, voters, with a shared interest living in your district.

Target - The voters you focus on in your campaign

Base - the people you know will vote for you-but they must be reminded

“Swing” - undecided voters that you need to persuade.

Turnout - number of voters who turn out to vote in an election.

% Turnout - percentage of registered voters who voted in an election.

Voter I.D. - Voter identification. A system of identifying which voters will vote for you and which will not and who remains undecided. Voter I.D. is done through phone canvassing, door knocking, one-on-one conversations, etc.

1's = Supporters

2's = Probable Supporters

3's = Undecided

4's = Voting for opponent

G.O.T.V. - **Get Out The Vote**. This describes efforts taken by the campaign to turnout voters who have said they will support your candidate.

Direct Mail - a piece of campaign literature sent to a group of voters. It can either be targeted (sent to voters who share a common interest) or general (sent to everyone in the district)

House parties - events (sometimes fundraisers) that gather neighbors and friends together to introduce and gain support for a candidate.

Canvassing - going door to door to introduce and persuade voters to vote for your candidate.

Visibility - Handheld signs that volunteers hold on the street.

Literature Drop - A group of volunteers leave flyers at the doors of homes.

1. Visit www.sos.la.gov
2. See “Elections & Voting” tab
3. Click “Get Election Information”
4. Click “Find Results & Statistics” from the bar on the left hand side
5. From there, you can:
 - a. View Graphical Election Results
 - b. See Voter Registration Statistics
 - c. Early Voting Statistics
 - d. Post-Election Turnout Statistics

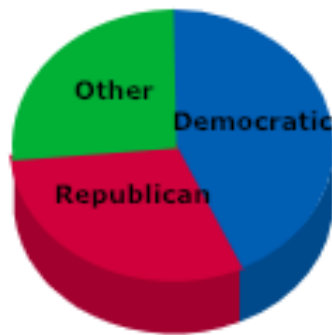

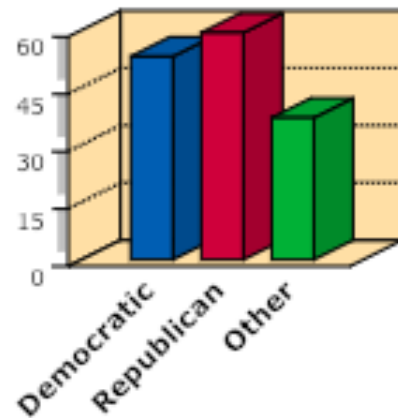

Turnout



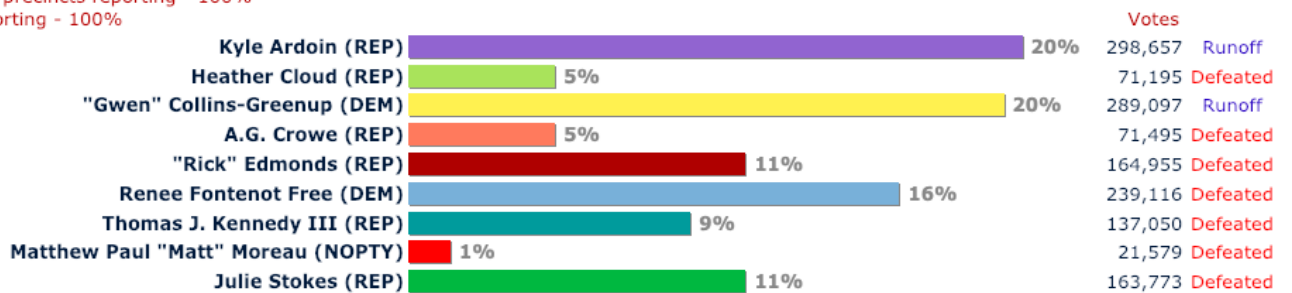

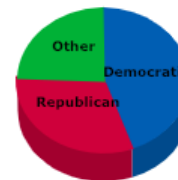

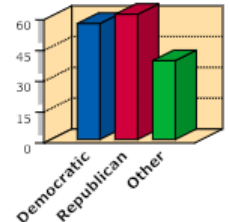
